## Market Comment

Agents yarded 11,821 sheep and lambs with Nutrien accounting for 2,555 of these. The majority of the yarding being airfreight and trade types. Heavy lambs sold \$130-\$181 with most sales \$140-\$150. Trade lambs sold strongly \$110-\$128 and airfreight \$75-\$111, while better store lambs \$60-\$75. Plainer types including woolly lambs \$40-\$62. Heavy mutton sold \$100-\$127, trade weight \$80-\$105 and boning grade \$60-\$75. Plain and poorer types \$20-\$44. Heavy hoggets \$100-\$137 with stores \$45-\$80. Ram lambs \$75-\$130, plain and store rams \$40-\$68 and aged rams \$20-\$55.
